Articles of Association

BE IT KNOWN, That we, the subscribers, do hereby associate ourselves as a body politic and corporate, pursuant to the statute laws of the State of Connecticut regulating the formation and organization of corporations without capital stock, and the following are our articles of association:

ARTICLE 1. the name of said corporation shall be the Connecticut Association of Boards of Education, Inc.

ARTICLE 2. the purposes for which said corporation is formed are the following to wit:

- a. To promote and stimulate interest in education.
- b. To develop more uniform procedures and standards for the direction of the public schools in the State of Connecticut.
- c. To provide for closer co-operation among the boards of education of the state and to provide information and assistance to individual boards of education and board members.
- d. Such services shall be rendered wholly on a non-profit basis.
- e. This corporation shall be wholly a charitable corporation devoted exclusively for educational and charitable purposes; and the real and personal property of the corporation shall be used exclusively for carrying out the aforesaid purposes.
- f. No officer, member or employee of the corporation shall receive any pecuniary profit from the operation thereof except reasonable compensation in effecting its purposes.

ARTICLE 3. The voting members of the corporation as provided in the by-laws shall constitute "the incorporators, their associates and successors" of said corporation.

ARTICLE 4. The said corporation is located in the town of Hartford.

Amendments (to Articles of Association)

The Articles of the Association were amended as follows on March 29, 1976:

ARTICLE 2, Sub-Section "e"

This corporation shall be wholly a non-profit corporation devoted to educational purposes; and the real and personal property of the corporation shall be used for carrying out the aforesaid purposes."
