- ◆ A CABE Search Services application (cabe.org, services, search services, application)
- ◆ A cover letter indicating interest in the position.
- ◆ A brief review of key professional accomplishments and explanation of how these will contribute to your success as Superintendent.
- ◆ A minimum of three recent letters of professional reference.
- ◆ Undergraduate and graduate transcripts and a copy of professional certification.
